## **Chapter In A Nutshell :-**

- 7<sup>th</sup> 12<sup>th</sup> century saw the emergence of new landlords and warrior chiefs called Samantas who gradually became important. They declared themselves Maha Samanta, Maha Mandaleshwara.
- **Dantidurga** a Rashtrakuta chief overthrew Chalukya overlord and performed 'Hiranya Garbha'.
- **Pratiharas, Palas, Rashtrakutas, Rajputs, Chauhans** were the main ruling dynasties in North India.
- Cholas, Pandyas, Chalukyas etc. were the ruling dynasties of South India.
- Many of these new Kings called themselves Maharaja adhiraja or tribhuvana chakravartin.
- **Prashastis** were composed by Brahmanas in praise of Kings.
- Tripartite struggle was there for kanauj.
- Vijayalaya captured power in 9<sup>th</sup> century and established Chola power.
- **Rajraja 1** was the most important ruler. Chola kingdom was administered through **Urs, Nadu, Sabha** and **Samiti**.
